# Attire Rules

Your outfits for skits are basically up to you. The theme of your skit is should dictate how you dress. Outfits must be kept appropriate.

Business attire is also required for the two-minute speech portion of the pageant within the same guidelines as the interview.

Finally, pageant attire is the last portion for the contest. Dresses are expected be long and not conspicuously tight fitting. No slits above the knee or low tops. Strapless is acceptable but cleavage is not.

I understand that if I/my child does not follow these guidelines, they will not score well in the pageant or if the outfit is deemed inappropriate they may be disqualified.
