RESOLUTION TO ADD A
REGULAR TOWN COUNCIL MEETING TO
THE MONTHLY SCHEDULE


WHEREAS, by ordinance and past practice the Town Council of the Town of Bronson meets in regular session for the general transaction of public business on the first Monday of each month; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary by virtue of the increase in public business and the need to afford all matters their requisite time and attention to add a meeting to the monthly agenda;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT SHALL BE AND IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Town Council shall henceforth conduct two regular monthly meetings for the general transaction of municipal business, on the first Monday of each month and on the third (3rd) Monday of each month, respectively.
2. Meetings may be cancelled, suspended, added or rescheduled administratively for good and sufficient reason by a majority vote of Council, but absent such action, the schedule set forth herein shall obtain.
3. This Resolution shall be duly publicly promulgated for the general information of the public.

REGARDING SEWER SYSTEM INITIATIVES**

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2010-02

WHEREAS, the Town of Bronson is committed to doing everything in its power for the benefit of its citizenry and enhancement of the quality of life in Bronson; and

WHEREAS, one element of the above consists of doing all that can reasonably, effectually and practically be done to improve, enhance, expand and maintain the sewer system; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Bronson Sewer Committee comprised of responsible, thoughtful and civic-minded individuals, has asked the Town Council for an affirmative indication of its intention in this regard.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above it is **RESOLVED THAT**:



The Town Council of the Town of Bronson hereby expresses its commitment to and endorsement of sewer initiatives, including the processing of applications for all available grants and programs related thereto and undertaking the necessary studies and analyses therefor; and relying on the good offices of the Sewer Committee and its members to assist in these endeavors with engineering oversight, administration and fiscal surveillance so as to ensure that the citizens of Bronson, individuals and businesses, are served.

2. It is expected and intended that the Sewer Committee, acting through Councilman Weeks as liaison, will continue to contribute and put forth its findings, strategies and proposals until the project is complete and optimal results achieved.

WHEREAS, it has been proposed to change the name of what is presently 2nd Street in the Town of Bronson to Ryleigh Drive; and

WHEREAS, it is the common and regular practice in the Town of Bronson to utilize actual names and not numbers as street designations as this is regarded as a more meaningful approach; and

WHEREAS, there is thus good cause and reason in the general public interest to make the aforesaid change for all technical, legal and practical applications;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Bronson in regular meeting assembled that:


1. The street presently called 2nd Street shall hence forth be and hereby is renamed "Ryleigh Drive" for all purposes and designations.
2. All relevant signs and other references to and indicia of street name shall be changed to conform accordingly and all authorities having an interest officially notified.
3. In the public interest and for the information of all concerned, this Resolution shall be published in a newspaper regularly circulated in the Town of Bronson and posted at the Municipal Headquarters.
4. The local United States Post Office shall be notified immediately, in writing, of the change hereby effected.
